Amends an on-call contract with AirVac Services, Inc. by adding one year for a new end date of 9-30-19 for disposal service of grease, oil, sand and other materials found in sand traps, lift stations, grease traps and associated kitchen drain lines in all city buildings flowing to active grease traps, citywide.
