House Bill 21-1262, approved by the Governor and State Legislature in 2021, created the Agricultural Stimulus Relief Program and appropriated funding to the Colorado Department of Agriculture aimed to help Colorado's agriculture industry recover faster and build back stronger from the global pandemic. The stimulus relief grant will aid in funding improvements to Phases 1 & 2 of the campus to support the National Western Stock Show and agriculture industry recovery and enable the Stock Show to attract and retain visitors and exhibitors in a highly competitive event environment.
