The Emergency Solutions Grant is a HUD funded grant that is awarded to all urban areas that reach specific size designations. The money from the grant will be used to fund services at four emergency shelters, one homelessness prevention program, and one rapid

rehousing program. The emergency shelter programs sit with the Delores Project, The Salvation Army, SafeHouse Denver, and Urban Peak. The homelessness prevention program is operated by Jewish Family Services. Lastly, the rapid rehousing program is operated by Volunteers of America Colorado.
